6. Submission Deadline:

All entries must be received by 19th December 2025 at 11:59 PM (BST).

7. Prizes:

Two winning schools will each receive one (1) Acer Charging Cart featuring the school's winning design. The prize is non-transferable and there is no cash alternative.

8. Judging Criteria:

Submissions will be judged by a panel selected by Acer UK based on creativity, originality, and representation of school spirit. The decision of the judging panel is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

9. Winner Notification:

Winners will be contacted by email and announced on 9th January 2025.

If a winner does not respond within 7 days of notification, Acer reserves the right to select an alternative winner.
